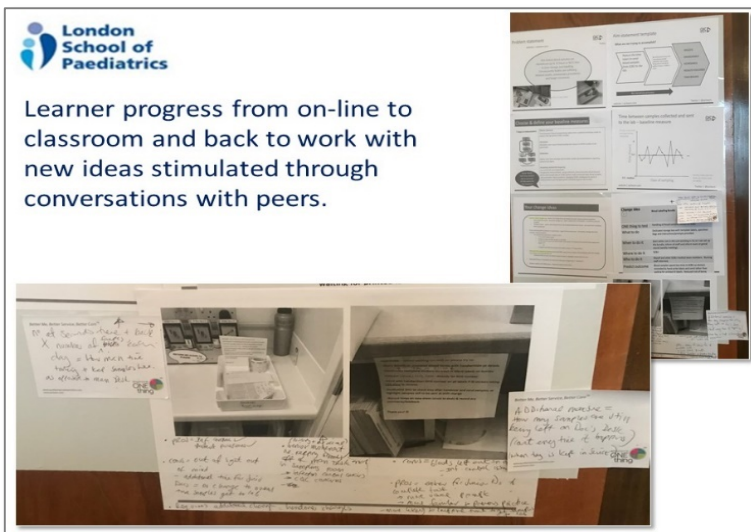


## Improve ONE thing: paediatrics

**Who attends?** We've had paediatric trainees, consultants, nurses, pharmacists and allied health professionals with patients and carers join us. You experience social learning; access an online community receiving feedback from each other and coaching from experienced mentors. In face-to-face sessions you build quickly on these shared experiences to make swift progress.

Learners completing the programme become recognized as QI Change Champions.

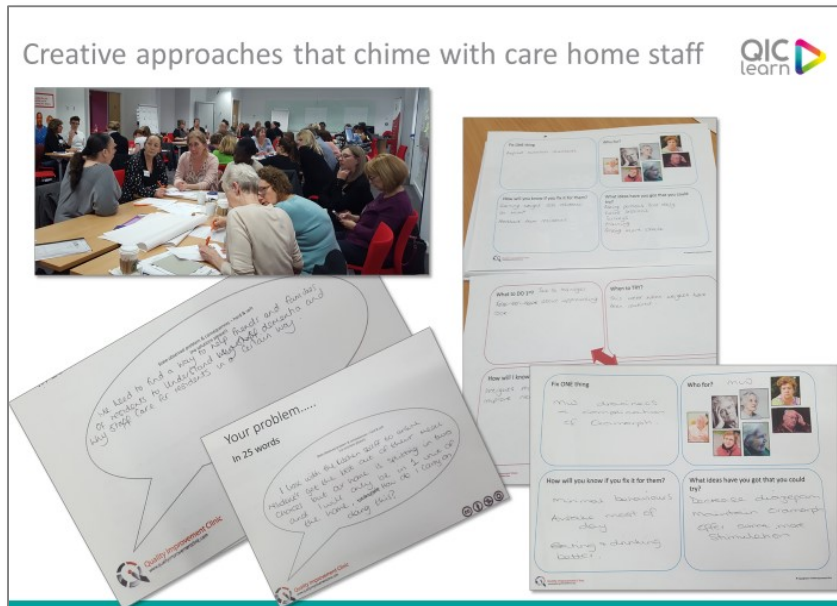


# Improve ONE thing: paediatrics
